Numarine 60 Flybridge

Turkey-based Numarine enjoys high repeat business from European customers, but within the past few months, it's been making a big push into the American market. The Fort Lauderdale International Boat Show this past November marked the U.S. premiere of the 60 Flybridge, which has the same sporty styling that characterizes all of Numarine's models. There's single-level living from the inside helm to the aft-deck seating area. There's also plenty of light and good visibility, particularly due to oversized windows on each side. Also noteworthy is the galley, which is open to the seating area, keeping a convivial atmosphere. Plenty of destinations await, as the 60 Flybridge can venture up to 375 nautical miles at top speed, made possible by the fuel-efficient and space-saving Volvo Penta IPS propulsion system. numarine.com
